Photography Workshop at PM Shri School JNV Kullu LAUNCHING OUR PHOTOGRAPHY JOURNEY!

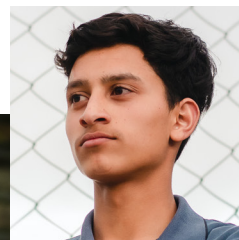

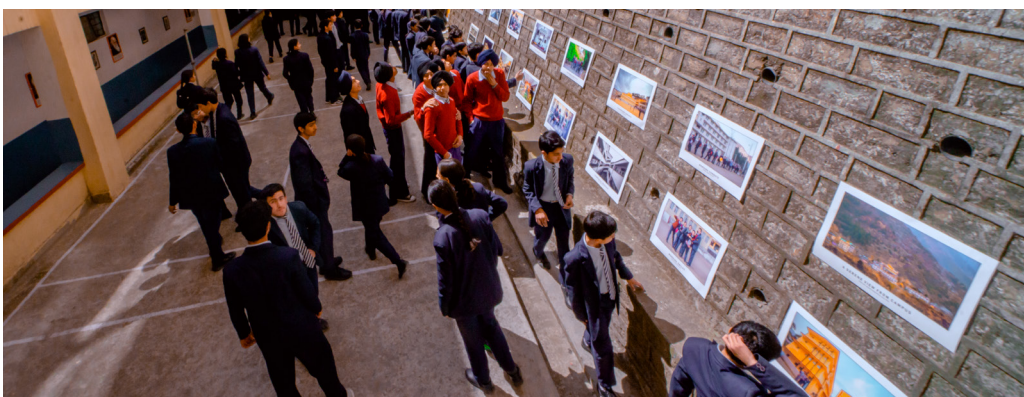
